If you will be entering the 7th, 8th or 9th grade next fall, we invite you to become a **Junior Volunteer or CIT**. Experience the fun of meeting new friends your own age, learning new skills, and helping others in a fun-filled environment that's just for kids!

counselors-in-training work closely with experienced teachers at the Museum's Mini Camps and learn responsibility by:

- providing friendly faces to help our campers transition into camp activities
- guiding campers in creative camp crafts
- developing important organizational, time management, and leadership skills

The cost is \$50 per 2 week session, and includes t-shirt, training, daily snacks and the possibility to apply for a future paid staff position here and at other camps. CIT hours are 8:30am-12:30pm, 3-days a week, and participants must enroll for 2 week blocks based on the Museum camp schedule.

If you are interested in becoming a CIT you must:

- attend the training session on **Tuesday, June 8 or Wednesday, June 9** from 4-5:30 pm.
- schedule a job shadow day

junior volunteers help the Museum's staff by:

- guiding visitors through science and art projects
- preparing craft materials for special projects
- helping keep the Museum clean and organized
- assisting with special Museum events, and many other opportunities

There is no fee, hours are flexible and can be arranged to accommodate family vacations or other summer programs.

If you are interested in becoming a junior volunteer you must:

- attend the training session on **Wednesday, June 16 or Thursday, June 17** from 4-5 pm.
